**CALL TO ORDER: @ 6:00 PM**

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:** “This time is set aside for the public to address the City Council on matters listed on the Consent Agenda as well as other items not included on the Regular Agenda. If your comments concern an item noted on the Regular Agenda, please address the Council when that item is open for public comment.” (The Brown Act requires the public be given the opportunity to address the Council before action is taken. If there is a Consent Agenda, there is no other opportunity for public comment on items on the Consent Agenda.) The Council has the right to reasonably limit the duration of each speaker to three minutes. Speakers may not cede their time. The Council may ask questions, but may take no action during the Public Comments portion of the meeting, except to direct staff to prepare a report, or to place an item on a future agenda.

The mayor will recognize you and ask that you state your name and mailing address so that the City Staff can follow up on any issues requiring City action, or provide you with information, if appropriate.

1. Discussion on the City of Montague Community Events:

Sherril Moore present with Friends of the Library. Would like to raise money for the Montague Library by doing a bake sale or root beer floats at the Stampede. Bill Nicoletti gave Sherril a contact number for the Stampede vendors.

Bill Nicoletti present with the Jefferson State Stampede. Reports this year is going to be bigger than previous years. There will be ranch sorting Friday night the 23<sup>rd</sup> put on by the team penners. Goat roping and the mechanical bull with bar and music. Mercy flights will be at Diggle field at 3:00 PM on the 24<sup>th</sup> for the kids to meet the team and look inside their helicopter. Main events of the rodeo start at 5 PM on the 24<sup>th</sup>. Grand entry will be law enforcement, ambulance and the Montague Fire Dept. There will be mutton busting, calf riding, roping, barrel racing, bull riding, saddle cow, bronc riding, steer riding etc. After the rodeo Fogline will be playing and fireworks will be set off. Nicoletti also reported that Rain Rock casino would like to help out in future Stampedes. The Stampede seems to bring in more and more interest every year.

Natalie Rizzardo present with YLL. Rizzardo reports that they just finished up with the season. Teams went further this year in the All Star division. The batting cage still needs to be fixed and she is looking into replacing the piping to get it approved for use. Nicoletti stated he will look into helping with that.

John Hammond present with Montague Rotary. Reported they will be serving alcohol at the Stampede. Discussed the upcoming car show and parade. Would like to put in an ice machine at the Community Hall to help with events. The rotary is looking forward to next year’s balloon fair.
